



Community meeting summary

17 April 2024

The Freedom and Fairness for Northern Cyprus campaign held its ninth community meeting.

These meetings are a forum for members and supporters of Turkish Cypriots in the UK and across the world to express their views and be a part of a campaign that seeks freedom and fairness for the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) and all those who live in there.

The following topics were discussed:



The campaign's ongoing discussions with former Ministers and current Shadow Ministers regarding topics including de-mining on the island of Cyprus, direct flights and disembarkation, and discrimination from sports.



The unprecedented and documented support gained by the campaign for the commencement of direct flights from the UK to Ercan International Airport from both the House of Commons and the House of Lords.



The discrimination facing many Turkish Cypriot athletes who suffer arbitrary bans from international sporting competitions ranging from motorsport, to taekwondo, from football to boxing.
